



### **The Moravian Seal**

The seal is of the Moravian Church. The image at the center dates back to the 1500s, and is referred to as the Agnus Dei - Latin for "Lamb of God." The lamb, which represents Jesus Christ, holds a staff with a banner representing victory.



### **The Moravian (Advent) Star**

The 26-point lighted stars, symbolizing Christ as the Light of the world, are hung in Moravian churches and homes. Their beauty is universal and they also appear in non-Moravian homes and establishments. The stars most likely originated in a Moravian school in Niesky Germany in the 1850's.



### **Covenant for Christian Living**

Moravians recognize the example of Christ's life and proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord. Living the Christian life depends not only on our own effort, but upon God our Father, who in Jesus Christ accepts us as heirs of God and strengthens and sustains us.
